- A Mini Band comprises 4 Pipers, 2 Snare Drummers, 1 Bass Drummer and optionally 1 Tenor Drummer
- Multiple entries are allowed up to 4 sets per band organisation per event-subject always to promoter's discretion to impose limits if the contest is oversubscribed.
- The Pipe Major, Lead Snare and Bass Drummer may compete in multiple sets in each event.
- All other performers may compete ONCE ONLY on the same instrument in each event.
- Bands playing their MSR on 6 June will play their Musical Selection at Castle Hill on Sun 8 August and vice versa.
