- All competing Band persons will be admitted free of charge whilst in Band uniform. 1.
- 2. Competitors will abide by the rules for their own particular section.
- 3. No entry fee will be refunded.
- 4. The committee reserve the right to postpone or cancel the games in the event of unfavourable weather or unforeseen circumstances.
- 5. The committee reserve the right to reject any entry, curtail, postpone, or cancel any event or otherwise deal with the program if they deem it necessary.
- 6. The area marshal is empowered to remove from the area any competitors for unseemly conduct. Any prize winner so offending shall be liable to have that prize forfeited.
- Competitors will not be waited for. Failure to attend when called for will forfeit the right 7. of competition.
- 8. All event winners must be in Highland Dress for presentation of prizes.
- 9. Winners of events will be presented with respective Prizes at the Massed Band at the end of competition. Any trophies presented will remain with the committee for safe keepina.
- 10. All Bands and competitors must be registered with their respective State Associations.
- 11. The contest will be conducted in accordance with the Australian Pipe Band Association Inc. Contest Regulation currently in force.
- 12. During the Pipe Band Contest no Piper or Drummer may play other than in defined areas.
- 13. Protests will be dealt with according to the "Australian Pipe Band Association Inc." Contest Rules in force at this time.
- 14. Fine Tuning area is to be used by only one Band at a time. The next Band to compete is to have preference.
- 15. Band personnel are requested to conduct themselves in an orderly manner when participating in the Mass Bands display.

- NO LIABILITY IS ACCEPTED FOR ANY INJURY OR LOSS SUSTAINED BY ANY 17. PERSON TAKING PART IN ANY EVENT IN THE PROGRAMME.
