- The Committee is looking for a candidate who is not working on improving their own skills as a musician but also at what the candidate gives back to the pipe band movement.

Previous recipients of this scholarship are ineligible to apply.

The scholarships are made up of the tuition fee & entrance to the recital of \$235:00 plus \$265:00 to help defray your other costs (accommodation, travel, meals etc.).

The workshop will be held at Canberra Burns Club, 8 Kett Street, Kambah ACT.
